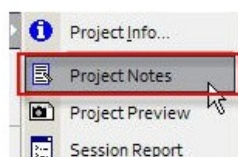




This month's Tech tips:

Embedded time stamped notes:

You can embed time-stamped notes in your ArchiCAD file using Project Notes. These can be accessed from the File menu> Info>Project Notes. They can be used to leave notes about the revisions you have made to the project, so that other users can see them, or as reminders for yourself.



Line work consolidation

If you have been bringing in external data that contains lines, then you can run a line work consolidation operation, which will remove and/or merge lines to reduce your project size. To access this dialog box, you must first select at least two or more line elements. Use Edit > Reshape > Line work Consolidation. The first time you execute this command you will bring up the Line type Consolidation Wizard. The wizard takes you through the consolidation options one by one. Note that each line consolidation option builds on the previous one; the program will execute the consolidation in the order in which they appear in the Wizard. On the last screen of the Wizard, check "Display simple Line work Consolidation Settings next time". This way, the next time you use the Edit > Reshape > Line work Consolidation command you will access the simplified Settings dialog box. A similar consolidation is available for fills. Both of these consolidations are also useful if you are intending to send out DWG's of sections or elevations for consultants to work on. When ArchiCAD generates a section or elevation it will frequently create duplicate lines where one element stops and the next starts. In this case copy the section or elevation into a Worksheet using the Worksheet Geometry Method "No Boundary" (ie. the first icon in the worksheet tool info box) and then run a consolidation on this. You can then create a view, and publish it as a DWG with the appropriate translator.

Interior wizard

The Interior Wizard command enhances the modelling of 3D Zones by applying Appearance

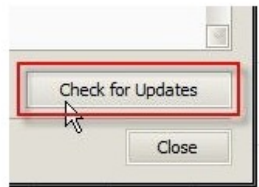

You can edit the shape and the material parameters of these elements using standard ArchiCAD tools as well as parametric functionality. The Interior Wizard recognizes wall openings and is updated if its associated zone is updated or changed. The Interior Wizard relies on the objects stored in the Accessories Library which must also be downloaded and is found in the Goodies.

Did you know that you can check for updates to the CadimageTools directly from ArchiCAD 12? Just go to the File menu and choose Activate Cadimage Tools, and then hit the Check for Updates button to see whether there are any new versions available to download from their website.



with non-Cadimage Tools Customers

"What happens if I need to send a file to an ArchiCAD user who doesn't have Cadimage Tools?" Basically, Cadimage suggest the 'non-Cadimage Tools' customer downloads and installs the required Tools. This ensures they have all the required Add-ons, Objects and Macros. They do not need to purchase the Tools to be able to download them. They simply need to register with the Cadimage website. If they simply install the Tools without purchasing them everything will display and print correctly, however, they will not be able to edit the placed objects. If the 'non-Cadimage Tools' customer chooses to, they can also register for a 30 day Trial Version from within ArchiCAD after they have installed the Tools.
